


Burbank House: Groundworks

Objective


I have been given the opportunity to draw for an upcoming book, titled "Burbank House :Groundworks", which will be sold internationally. In October of 2021, Tsubi Club, the artist behind the project, released a song titled "Burbank House", along with a music video that tells a visual story. To further develop this fictional storyline he has created, he is producing this book that goes into detail about each character, the different settings of the world, the different plotlines, and more. However, the main focus of the book isn't the material, but how it is created. To complete this book, Tsubi Club has hired 100 artists to bring their different art styles together to create a visually appealing and diversified collaboration. My role for the book, labeled as a "Page Artist", is to fill up one spread of the book with as many drawings as I would like. Specifically, I am contributing hyperrealism. For my individual spread, I decided to fill it up with two large drawings - size 14 inch by 20 inch. Because the two drawings took well over 200 hours to draw and the deadline was during the semester, this project was completed for credit as an internship.

Progress




The two drawings were completed within two months, drawing an average of 40 hours per week.
